- The highest headcount recorded in a day nursery in the week commencing 20th April was 32 key worker children.
- The average daily headcount across all open settings was 5.95 key worker children, falling to 4.00 when measured using the median, which is less influenced by outlying values.
- The highest recorded headcount for vulnerable children attending a setting was 6, and the average daily headcount across all open provision was 0.72 vulnerable children per open setting.
